As you know, the Government is taking steps to limit the number of people gathering together to help curb the spread of the Corona Virus, or COVID-19. Last night, the Brothers Without Borders Directors met together to discuss the organizations response to the virus, as well as how to proceed with our upcoming events.

First and foremost, scripture calls us to be people of truth and obedience, and with the restrictions on large group gatherings placed by New York State, the difficult call was made to **reschedule the Banquet until September 11, 2020**. All tickets that have been sold will be honored, as well as donated baskets placed for auction on that night.
